Application 2004-0985-6 Public Hearing in the National Capital Region 21 March 2005

CKLY-FM City of Kawartha Lakes (Lindsay) – Technical change

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by CHUM Limited to change the authorized contours of the radio programming undertaking CKLY-FM City of Kawartha Lakes (Lindsay), by decreasing the average effective radiated power from 14,000 watts to 5,270 watts, by increasing the antenna height and by relocating the transmitter.
- 2. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 3. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
