Use of frequency 99.3 MHz by the new English-language FM radio station in Edmonton

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Rawlco (Edmonton) Ltd. (Rawlco) to operate its new English-language FM radio station in Edmonton at 99.3 MHz (channel 257C1) with an average effective radiated power of 100,000 watts.
2. Rawlco filed this application in response to the Commission's direction in *Smooth jazz Specialty FM radio station in Edmonton*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2004-136, 5 April 2004 (Decision 2004-136). The applicant had originally proposed to operate its new station at 89.3 MHz (channel 207C1) with an effective radiated power of 100,000 watts. In Decision 2004-136, the Commission stated that it would only issue a licence for this station provided that the applicant submitted an application proposing the use of another FM frequency that would be acceptable to both the Commission and to the Department of Industry (the Department).
3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with the present application.
4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, the licence for this undertaking will only be issued once the Department has notified the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
