CHON-FM Whitehorse, Yukon Territory and its transmitter VF2147 Destruction Bay – Technical change

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Northern Native Broadcasting, Yukon to change the authorized contours of its transmitter VF2147 Destruction Bay, by increasing the effective radiated power from 2 watts to 10 watts.
- 2. The Commission notes that there will be no significant change to the authorized contours.
- 3. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
- 5. Given that the technical parameters approved in this decision are for a low-power unprotected FM service, the Commission also reminds the licensee that it will have to select another frequency if the Department so requires.
