Newsworld - Licence amendment

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) to amend the broadcasting licence for the national, specialty programming undertaking known as Newsworld.
- 2. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 3. In *Licences for Newsworld and RDI renewed for a seven-year term,* Decision CRTC 2000-3, 6 January 2000, the Commission imposed the following condition of licence relating to the measurement of Canadian content:
 - 2. The licensee shall devote no less than 90% of the broadcast week to the distribution of Canadian programs.

For the purpose of this condition, "broadcast week" means seven consecutive broadcast days, beginning on Sunday.

- 4. The CBC proposed to replace condition of licence no. 2 with the following condition:
 - 2. In each broadcast year, the licensee shall devote at least 90% of its programming to the distribution of Canadian programs during the broadcast day.
