CORRECTION TO ITEM 2

Peace River, High Prairie, Fairview, Valleyview and Saddle Hills, Alberta Application No. 2005-1535-6

Application by Peace River Broadcasting Corporation Ltd. to amend the licence of radio programming undertaking CKYL Peace River.

The Department of Industry has advised the Commission that the technical parameters for the proposed transmitters at Peace River, Saddle Hills and High Prairie, that were initially submitted in Application No. 2005-1535-6, have been revised as follows:

The transmitter at Peace River would operate on frequency **94.9** MHz (channel **235A**) with an effective radiated power of 2,900 watts (non-directional antenna/antenna height of 115.3 metres

The transmitter at Saddle Hills would operate on frequency 88.9 MHz (channel **205B1**) with an effective radiated power of 2,500 watts (non-directional antenna/antenna height of **228.1** metres).

The transmitter at High Prairie would operate on frequency **92.1** MHz (channel **221A**) with an effective radiated power of 1,400 watts (non-directional antenna/antenna height of 117.4 metres).
