CKJM-FM Chéticamp – New transmitter at Pomquet

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by La Coopérative Radio Chéticamp Limitée to amend the broadcasting licence for the French-language community Type A radio programming undertaking CKJM-FM Chéticamp, Nova Scotia, in order to operate a transmitter at Pomquet, Nova Scotia.
- 2. The new transmitter will operate at 92.5 MHz (channel 223A1) with an effective radiated power of 475 watts.
- 3. The licensee indicated that the transmitter would help the station reach the Acadian Francophones of the region.
- 4. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
- 6. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 6 September 2009. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
