CFOI-FM Québec – New transmitter in Saint-Jérôme

1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Association des Églises baptistes réformées du Québec to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CFOI-FM Québec in order to add an FM transmitter in Saint-Jérôme to rebroadcast the programming of CFOI-FM in its entirety. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
2. The new transmitter will operate at 102.9 MHz (channel 275A1) with an effective radiated power of 200 watts (non-directional antenna with an effective height of antenna above average terrain of 47.3 metres).
3. The licensee stated that an association of members from the Baptist church located in Saint-Jérôme participate in the programming of CFOI-FM on a regular basis. This association wishes to have access to all of CFOI-FM's programming in their community.
4. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
6. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 21 January 2013. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
