## **CBQT-FM Thunder Bay – New transmitter in Schreiber**

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CBQT-FM Thunder Bay, Ontario, to operate an FM rebroadcasting transmitter in Schreiber to rebroadcast the programming of its national, English-language network service Radio One. The new FM transmitter will replace the low-power AM transmitter CBLB Schreiber. The Commission did not receive any interventions regarding this application.
- 2. The new transmitter will operate at 90.9 MHz (channel 215A1) with an effective radiated power of 130 watts (non-directional antenna with an effective height of antenna above average terrain of 31.3 metres).
- 3. The licensee stated that the transmitter would improve the quality of the Radio One signal and would allow it to reach more residents in Schreiber and surrounding areas.
- 4. Pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
- 5. The transmitter must be in operation by no later than **13 May 2021**. To request an extension, the licensee must submit a written request to the Commission at least 60 days before that date, using the form available on the Commission's website.
