CBTK-FM Kelowna and its transmitter CBUM-FM Nakusp – Technical changes

- 1. The Commission approves the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) to change the authorized contours of CBUM-FM Nakusp, British Columbia, a low-power rebroadcasting transmitter of the English-language radio programming undertaking CBTK-FM Kelowna (Radio One), by changing the frequency from 91.3 MHz (channel 217LP) to 99.9 MHz (channel 260LP) and increasing the effective height of the antenna above average terrain from -107 to -59.14 metres. All other parameters remain unchanged. The Commission did not receive any interventions regarding this application.
- 2. The licensee stated that the proposed technical changes are required to operate a different antenna than the one that the licensee initially proposed when it previously applied to add CBUM-FM to the licence of CBTK-FM and to permit its operation as a rebroadcasting transmitter.¹
- 3. Pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry (the Department) notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
- 4. The Department's *BPR-3: Application Procedures and Rules for FM Broadcasting Undertakings* specifies that a low-power FM radio rebroadcasting transmitter is considered a secondary assignment operating on an unprotected channel. Should an FM station or transmitter with protected status be granted a frequency that is incompatible with that used by the low-power transmitter considered in this decision, the licensee may need to cease the operation of that low-power transmitter or file an application to change its frequency and/or technical parameters.

5. The licensee must implement the technical changes by no later than **18 September 2021**. To request an extension, the licensee must submit a written request to the Commission at least 60 days before that date, using the form available on the Commission's website.
