Talentvision – Revocation of licence

- 1. Fairchild Television Ltd. has requested the revocation of its broadcasting licence for the ethnic, third-language specialty Category A service Talentvision, which was renewed in Broadcasting Decision 2013-468, in order to continue its operation as an exempt undertaking, pursuant to Broadcasting Order 2015-88.
- 2. Given the licensee's request and pursuant to section 9(1)(e) of the *Broadcasting Act*, the Commission **revokes** the broadcasting licence issued to Fairchild Television Ltd. for the above-mentioned undertaking.
- 3. The operator of this undertaking must, at all times, comply with the criteria set out in the appendix to Broadcasting Order 2015-88.
