Re: Fulfillment of Competitive Local Exchange Obligations

2034156 ONTARIO INC. is pleased to inform the Commission that it has met the Commission's Competitive Local Exchange Carrier ("CLEC") obligations as set out in CRTC Telecom Decision 97-8, Local Competition ("Decision 97-8"). As a result, it is ready to provide local exchange services as early as 1 July 2005 in a number of Local Interconnection Regions (LIRs) in area codes 416 and 905, as indicated in its letters to the Commission dated 22 November 2004 and 23 November 2004.

Specifically, 2034156 ONTARIO INC. has completed the following activities:

- 2034156 ONTARIO INC. has obtained a Central Office code for each exchange in which it intends to provide local exchange service and has designated a point of interconnection ("POI") for each LIR in area codes 416 and 905.
- 2034156 ONTARIO INC. has signed and filed with the Commission all of the applicable interconnection agreements between itself and the carriers with which it exchanges traffic.
- 2034156 ONTARIO INC. has filed its interconnection tariffs for Local Exchange Carriers ("LECs"), Interexchange Carriers ("IXCs") and Wireless Service Providers ("WSPs"). These tariffs were approved by the Commission on 19 January 2005 in Telecom Order CRTC 2005-30.

- 2034156 ONTARIO INC. has implemented Local Number Portability (“LNP”).
- 2034156 ONTARIO INC. will provide Message Relay Service (“MRS”) to its local subscribers.
- 2034156 ONTARIO INC. has implemented the appropriate procedures to provide 9-1-1 services to its local subscribers using Bell Canada’s Emergency Service (9-1-1) tariff. A copy of the 9-1-1 agreement between Bell Canada and 2034156 ONTARIO INC. was approved by the Commission on 13 December 2004 in Telecom Order CRTC 2004-416.
- Included in 2034156 ONTARIO INC.’s interconnection tariff are the terms and conditions under which it will provide subscriber listings to other LECs. An unexecuted copy of 2034156 ONTARIO INC.’s Basic Listing Interexchange File (“BLIF”) Agreement was filed with the Commission and was approved by the Commission on 12 January 2005 in Telecom Order CRTC 2005-18.
- 2034156 ONTARIO INC. will ensure that its end-users have direct access, under reasonable terms and conditions, to services provided by any other LEC serving in the exchange.
- A copy of 2034156 ONTARIO INC.’s PIC/CARE Handbook will be filed with the Commission for its approval coincident with the first request 2034156 ONTARIO INC. receives for equal access, which it expects to receive this spring. 2034156 ONTARIO INC. will use the latest CISC PIC/CARE handbook dated July 2003 as the model for its PIC/CARE handbook.

2034156 ONTARIO INC. is able to exchange the minimum set of CCS7 message types and has configured its network to ensure that customer privacy is protected by enabling the following features:

- Delivery of the privacy indicator when invoked by an end customer;
- Provision of automated universal per call blocking of calling line identification;
- Provision of per line call display blocking to qualified end customers;
- Disallowance of Call Return to a blocked number; and
- Provision of universal Call Trace.

Further, 2034156 ONTARIO INC. has procedures in place to enforce the Commission’s restrictions on Automatic Dialing-Announcing Devices, Automatic Dialing Devices, and unsolicited facsimiles applicable in Bell Canada’s territory.

In order to obtain numbering, provide LNP and remit contribution appropriately, 2034156 ONTARIO INC. has contacted and is participating, as required, in the following organizations:

- Canadian Numbering Consortium Inc.
- Canadian LNP Consortium Inc.
- Canadian Portable Contribution Consortium Inc.

2034156 ONTARIO INC. filed with the Commission on 17 December 2004 all of the information identified in paragraphs 291, 292, 293 and 295 of Telecom Decision 97-8. The Commission approved this application on 19 January 2005 in Telecom Order **CRTC 2005-30**.

A copy of this letter will be provided to the Central Funds Administrator, the three consortia, and all LECs and proposed CLECs operating in 2034156 ONTARIO INC.'s proposed serving areas.
