Rogers would like to further advise the Commission that it no longer intends to offer local exchange service at this time in the Newfoundland exchanges of Harbour Main and Clarenville, contrary to Roger's letter on this matter of 25 May 2006.

In accordance with paragraph 343 of Decision 2005-28, RCCI will continue to conform to the CLEC obligations set out in Decision 97-8 and the Commission's subsequent rulings.

Pursuant to Telecom Decision CRTC 97-8 (Decision 97-8), paragraphs 291 and 295, copies of the serving area maps are attached and are provided to ILECs, CLECs and proposed CLECs identified on the Commission's web site.

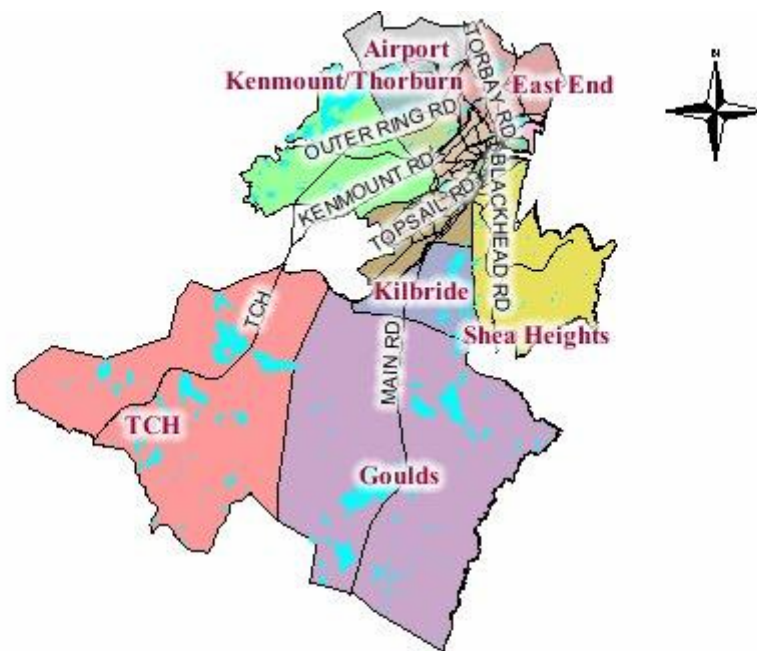
