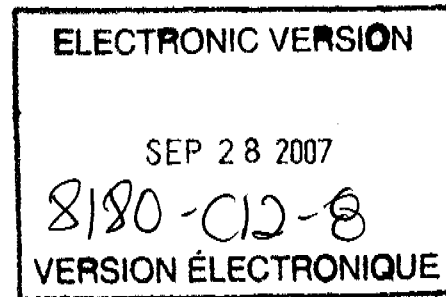

Re: Entry as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) in the regions of Hull, Montreal, Oshawa, Ottawa, Quebec, and Richmond Hill.

In accordance with the procedures set out in paragraph 295 of Telecom Decision 97-8 (the Decision), Distributel Communications Limited (Distributel) hereby notifies the Commission that it plans to provide services as a CLEC in all the exchanges included in the following Local Interconnection Regions (LIRs) as listed in Bell's Access Services Tariff (Item 105) :

- Hull, Qc (HULLPQ20)
- Montreal, Qc (MTRLPQ02)
- Oshawa, On (OSHWON95)
- Ottawa, On (OTWAON23)
- Quebec, Qc (QUBCPQ15)
- Richmond Hill, On (RMHLON34)

Distributel will continue to comply with the CLEC obligations set out in the Decision.

Distributel is also providing the Commission maps of the serving areas for the regions listed above. A copy of this letter and maps will be served to Local Exchange Carriers and proposed CLECs, serving or proposing to serve, the exchanges in the above regions, as identified on the Commission's web site as of the date of this letter.

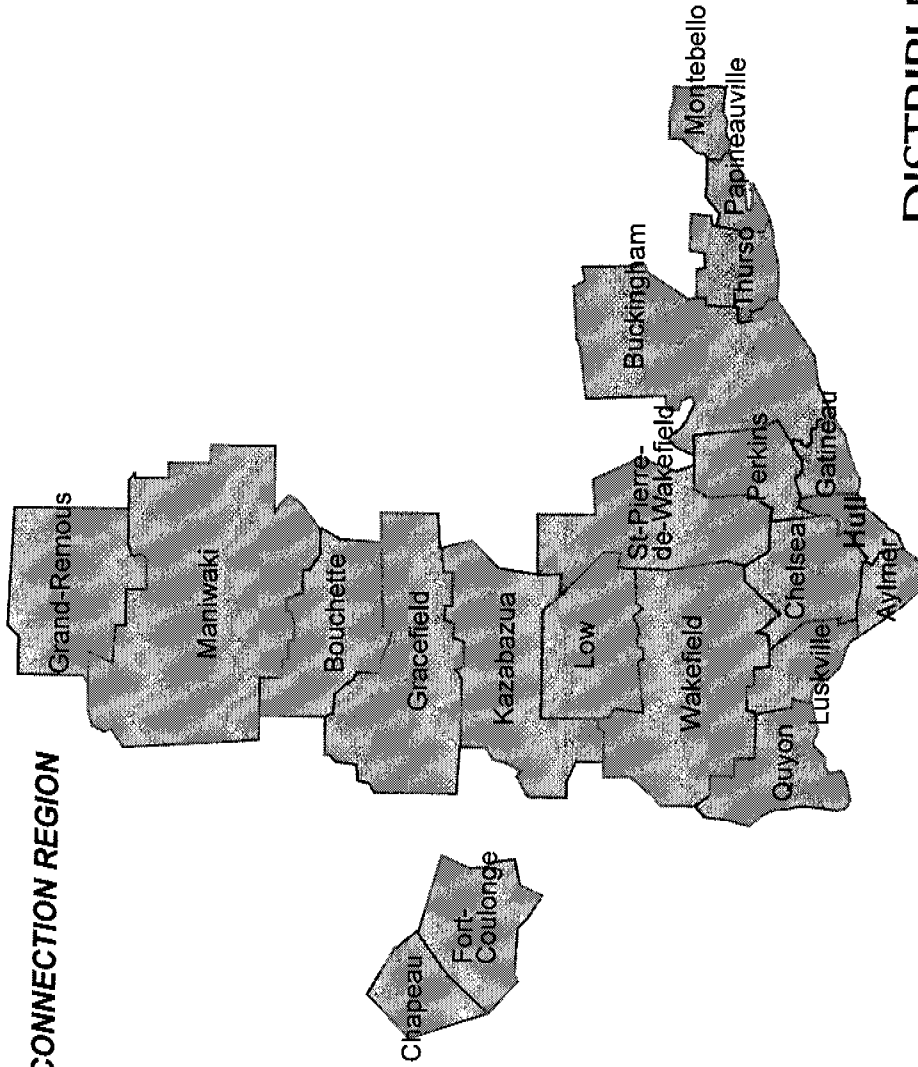

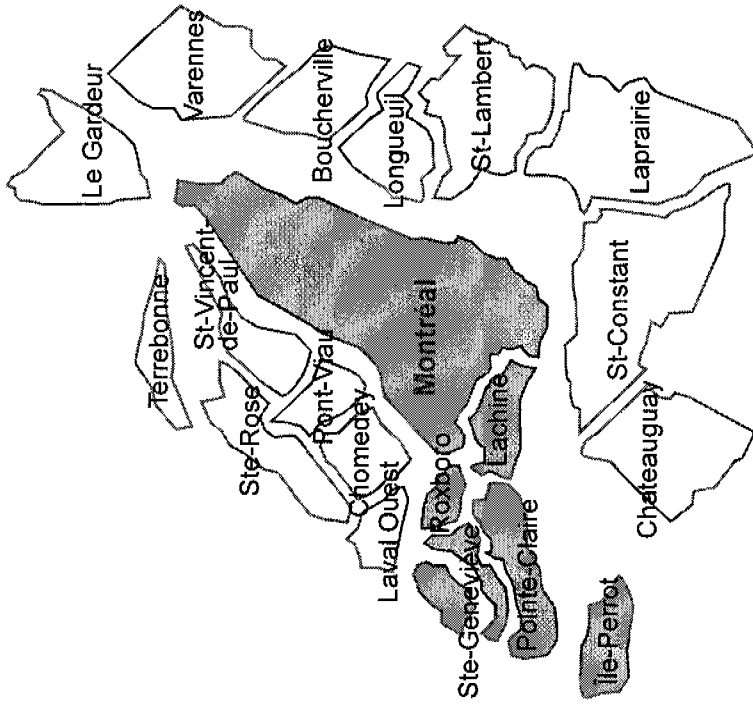

LOCAL INTERCONNECTION REGION**



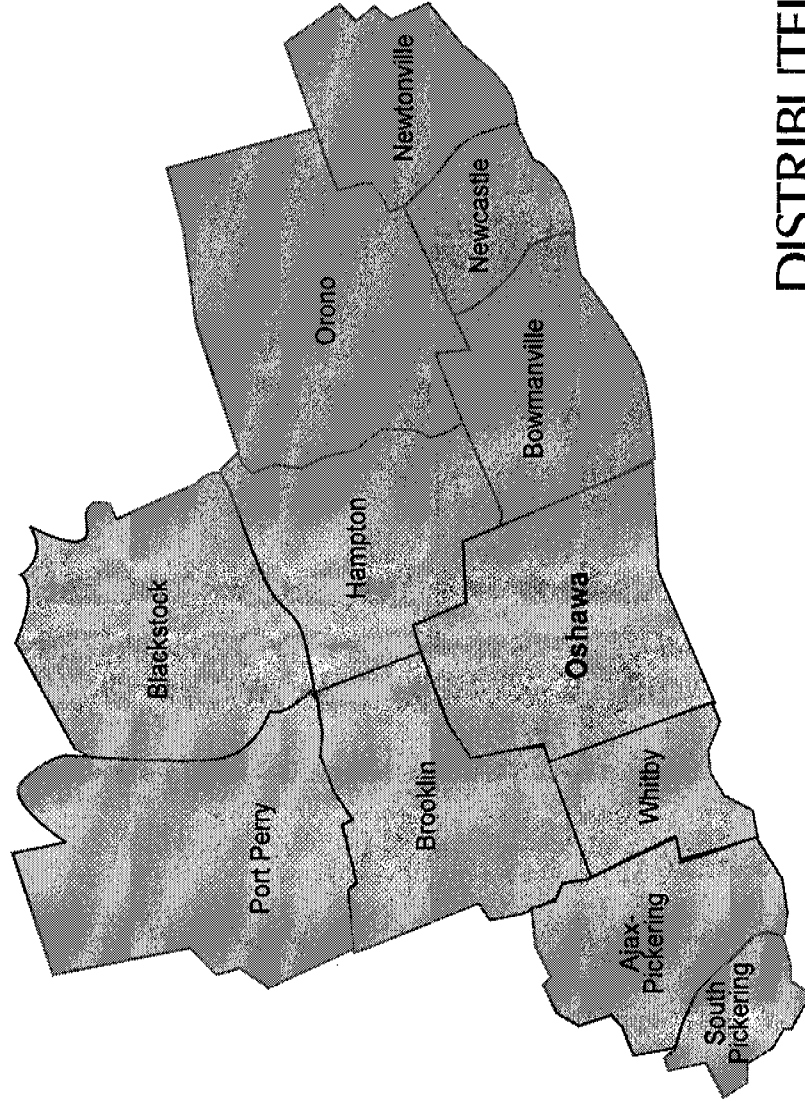

LOCAL INTERCONNECTION REGION**

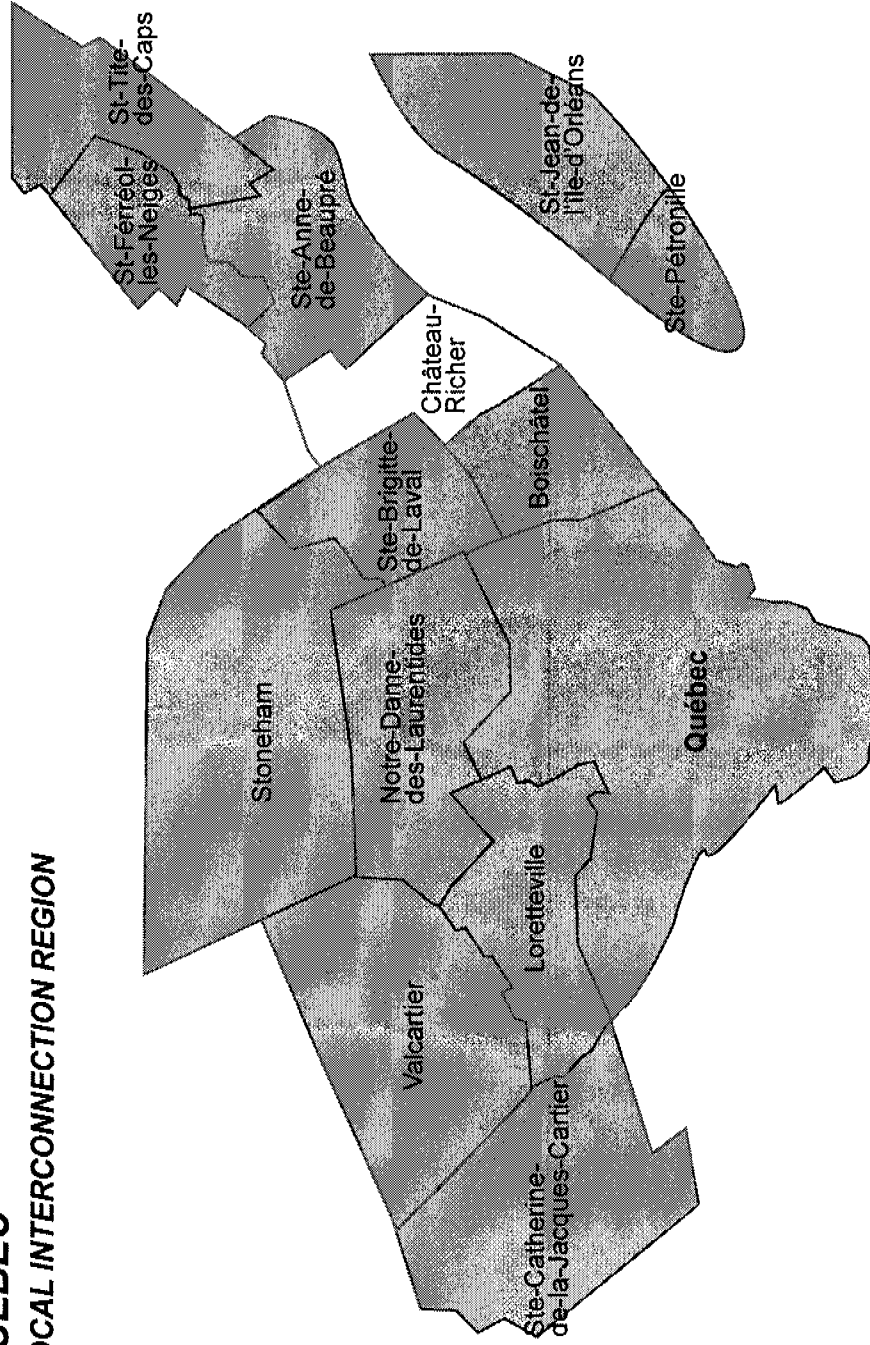
