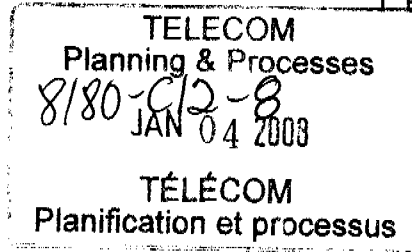



Subject: Competitive Local Exchange Carrier Registration

1. Pursuant to Telecom Decision 97-8, Local Competition (Decision 97-8) Execulink Telecom Inc (Execulink) hereby submits this letter as notice of intent to enter People's Tel Limited Partnership (People's) territory as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC). Execulink hereby provides written notice of its intent to enter the local exchange telephone market and offer local switched services to customers located in Forest and Arkona, Ontario, Canada.
2. As specified within paragraph 295 of decision 97-8, Execulink attests to the following:
  - Execulink understands and will conform to the obligations set forth in Decision 97-8 and acknowledges that it will not offer any commercial local exchange services to the public until all conditions of the Decision 97-8 have been satisfied (see Attachment);
  - Execulink will provide a copy of the Registration Letter with all registered Local Exchange Carriers in the territory of People's and all other carriers which have filed a letter of registration with the Commission indicating the intention to become CLEC within the territory of People's.
  - Execulink will submit its proposed interconnection agreements and tariffs for Commission approval once such agreements and tariffs have been implemented;
  - Execulink will file serving area maps with the Commission prior to providing commercial services to the public and will make such service area maps available upon request; and,
  - Execulink will inform the Commission when compliance of all conditions of Decision 97-8 is met.

## Description of Fulfillment of CLEC Entry Obligations

### **1. Access – Other Carriers and Services**

It is the intent of Execulink Telecom Inc (Execulink) to enter into the necessary interconnection agreements with those carriers who will be interconnecting with Execulink, either directly or through transiting arrangements. Upon request, Execulink will also file the necessary tariffs for wireless service provider (WSP) interconnection and interexchange carrier (IXC) equal access.

### **2. LEC to LEC Interconnection**

Execulink intends to sign a form of the Master Agreement for Local Interconnection with People's Tel Limited Partnership (People's) and with any CLECs operating within People's serving territory. In cases where Execulink does not have direct interconnection with a CLEC within People's territory, Execulink intends to use People's to exchange traffic with the other CLECs. Execulink also commits to implement local number portability (LNP) as approved by the Commission.

### **3. Access to Operator Services**

Execulink will provide 9-1-1 service and Message Relay Service (MRS) to its customers.

### **4. Privacy Protection**

Execulink will satisfy all existing and future regulatory requirements designed to protect customer privacy.

### **5. Other Obligations**

Execulink will make available upon request all of the following consumer information prior to offering service to the public:

- local calling area boundaries;
- details of all service options, with applicable prices;
- details of all potentially applicable service charges;
- policy on access to enhanced service providers;
- available special need services; and
- information regarding privacy, including Execulink Telecom Inc's responsibilities with regard to protecting the confidentiality of customer records.

Execulink will file with the Commission the following customer information and Execulink policies prior to contracting for service with its customers or offering service to the public:

- billing frequency and payment policy;
- disconnection policy;
- security deposit policy;
- policy on directories;
- the name and address of the company providing service to the customer;

- a toll-free telephone number from which the customer can obtain further information or lodge a complaint;
- billing date;
- due date for payment;
- interest rates applicable to late payments;
- information with respect to access to 9-1-1 service and MRS, including customer charges as required in Part XIV of Decision 97-8; and
- information with respect to safety and privacy protection, as required in Decision 97-8.

Execulink will abide by the Commission requirements regarding billing information and billing inserts in alternative formats accessible to visually-impaired subscribers contained in Telecom Order 98-626.

#### **6. Application for NXXs and Other Numbering Resources**

Execulink will submit its applications to the Canadian Number Administrator for NXXs and Local Routing Numbers (LRNs) in the exchanges in which it intends to provide local services.

1. Pursuant to Telecom Decision 97-8, Local Competition (Decision 97-8) Execulink Telecom Inc (Execulink) hereby submits this letter as notice of intent to enter People's Tel Limited Partnership (People's) territory as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC). Execulink hereby provides written notice of its intent to enter the local exchange telephone market and offer local switched services to customers located in Forest and Arkona, Ontario, Canada.
2. Execulink has sent a letter to the CRTC attesting that it will follow the conditions as specified within paragraph 295 of decision 97-8. A copy is attached. In addition a copy of a document entitled 'Description of Fulfillment of CLEC Entry Obligations' which has also been filed with the CRTC is also attached.
3. A copy of the LIR forecast is attached to assist in interconnection engineering.
4. To avoid any confusion, Execulink is requesting that People's do the following:
  - Enter into a MALI Agreement
  - Interconnect via shared cost facilities
  - Implement Local Number Porting
5. Execulink intends to provide service on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008
6. Please confirm receipt of this *bonafide* request forthwith or respond within 10 days with any deficiencies.
