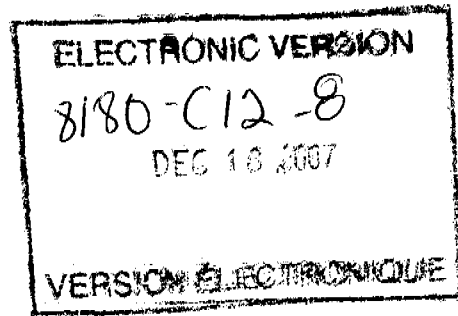

Dear Mr. Morin:

Shaw Telecom Inc. ("Shaw") herein informs the Commission that it has met the following Competitive Local Exchange Carrier ("CLEC") obligations as set out in Telecom Decision 97-8, *Local Competition* and those requirements set out in paragraph 344 of Telecom Decision CRTC 2005-28, *Regulatory framework for voice communication services using Internet Protocol*, and is ready to provide local exchange services in the exchange of Sault Ste Marie, Ontario.

Shaw attests it has completed the following:

1. Shaw has obtained a Central Office code in Sault Ste Marie.
2. Shaw has completed PSTN interconnection and signaling POIs have been established in the Number Plan Area ("NPA").
3. Shaw and Bell Aliant Regional Communications, Limited Partnership are in the final stages of executing the Commission-approved standard Master Agreement for Local Interconnection (MALI). The Schedule C to the MALI will be filed in confidence with the Commission within seven days of execution pursuant to paragraph 48 to Telecom Decision CRTC 2007-129.
4. Shaw and Bell Aliant Regional Communications, Limited Partnership are in the final stages of executing the Commission-approved standard Master Agreement for LEC-IXC Interconnection dated December 7, 2007.
5. Shaw has filed its CLEC tariffs for Local Exchange Carriers ("LECs"), Interexchange Carriers ("IXC") and Wireless Service Providers ("WSPs"). These tariffs were granted interim approval by the Commission in Telecom Order CRTC 2007-431.
6. Shaw is capable of providing Local Number Portability ("LNP").
7. Shaw is able to provide Message Relay Service ("MRS") to its subscribers.
8. Shaw has implemented the appropriate procedure to provide 9-1-1 services to its subscriber using the ILEC's 9-1-1 Tariff.
9. Included in Shaw's interconnection tariff are the terms and conditions under which it will provide subscriber listings to other LECs. An unexecuted copy of Shaw's Basic Listing Interexchange File ("BLIF") agreement was filed with the Commission on 23 August 2004 and was approved by the Commission in Telecom Order CRTC 2004-325.



10. Shaw will ensure that its end-users have access, under reasonable terms and conditions, to services provided by other LECs serving the exchange.
11. Shaw is able to exchange the minimum set of CCS7 message types and has configured its network to ensure that customer privacy is protected by enabling the following features:
 - Delivery of the privacy indicator when invoked by an end customer;
 - Provision of automated universal per-call blocking on calling line identification;
 - Provision of per line call display blocking to qualified end customers;
 - Disallowance of Call return to a blocked number; and
 - Provision of Universal Call Trace.
12. Shaw has implemented procedures to enforce the Commission's restrictions on Automatic Dialing-Announcing Devices, Automatic dialing Devices and unsolicited facsimiles.
13. Shaw is participating in the following organizations:
 - Canadian Numbering Consortium Inc.
 - Canadian LNP Consortium Inc.
 - Canadian Portable Contribution Consortium Inc.
14. Shaw provides all information identified in paragraphs 291, 292, 293 and 295 of Telecom Decision 97-8 to customers upon request. The information is available on Shaw's website to all customers (www.shaw.ca). Shaw is filing with the Commission its serving area map for the Sault Ste Marie exchange.
15. Shaw is able to provide Equal Access to an IXC requesting the service.

A copy of this letter is provided to all LECs operating in this exchange. Shaw will also serve a copy of this letter to the Canadian Numbering Administrator, the Canadian Local Number Portability Consortium, the Canadian Portable Contribution Consortium and the Central Fund Administrator.
