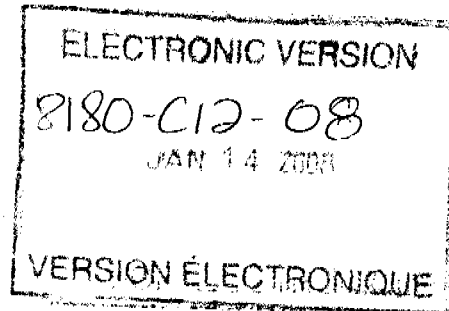

Subject: Bell Canada – Expansion of Serving Area

1. In a letter dated 17 April 2000, the Commission recognized the former Bell Intrigna now Bell Canada as having met CLEC requirements sufficient to allow it to provide local switched services.
2. Pursuant to the directives outlined in Telecom Decision CRTC 97-8, *Local Competition* (Decision 97-8), Bell Canada (or the Company) is notifying the Commission that it has completed the expansion of its current local serving areas to include the TELUS Communications Company (TELUS) exchange of Whistler, British Columbia.
3. Bell Canada has successfully met all the CLEC requirements as outlined in Decision 97-8 prior to offering service in the above-noted exchange.
4. Attached is the serving area map for the exchange noted above.
5. Modifications to Schedule C of the Bell/TELUS MALI agreement with respect to the Squamish - Lillooet Local Interconnection Region (LIR) are underway and will be filed with the Commission upon completion.
