Re: Bragg Communications Inc. notification to expand CLEC Serving Area to select Ontario exchanges

Bragg Communications Inc., carrying on business as EastLink ("EastLink"), hereby provides notification to the Commission of its intention to further expand its CLEC serving area in Ontario. **In addition to the exchanges listed in our October 15, 2008 notification**, EastLink is also planning to enter the following exchanges as quickly as interconnection arrangements can be completed with the respective incumbents:

Bell Exchanges:

Durham and Chelsey to be included with the Owen Sound LIR
Arthur and Mount Forest (Orangeville LIR)

Independent Exchanges:

Paisley (Bruce Municipal Telephone – *in addition to Port Elgin that had been identified previously*)
Mildmay, Neustadt and Ayton (Wightman Telephone)
Milverton (Mornington Communications)
Dashwood (Hay Communications)

EastLink will conform to the CLEC obligations set out in Decision 97-8, as well as subsequent rulings, and will fulfill these terms of entry prior to providing service as a CLEC in these exchanges. We will also provide the applicable serving area maps prior to launching in each exchange, in addition to filing the required interconnection agreements and tariffs for these exchanges for Commission approval once such documents have been negotiated and executed.
