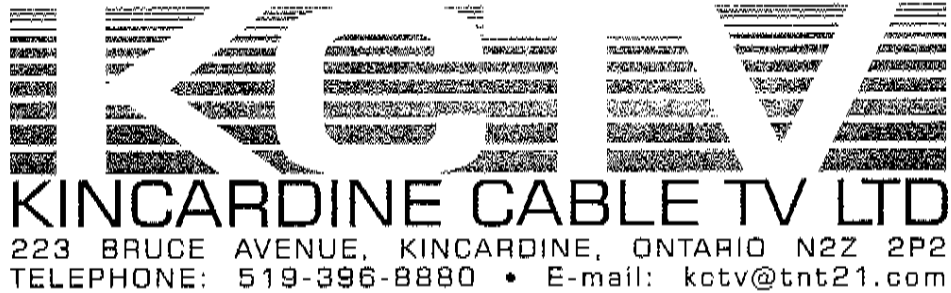



**Re: Kincardine Cable TV Ltd. -  
Competitive Local Exchange Carrier Registration**

1. Pursuant to Telecom Decision CRTC 97-8 (Decision 97-8), Kincardine Cable TV Ltd. submits this letter as notice of intent to enter the local exchange telephone market and offer switched local telephone services as a competitive local exchange carrier (CLEC).
2. Kincardine Cable is a small family owned cable television company which currently provides video and high speed internet services to almost 5000 subscribers in a number of small communities near Lake Huron in Ontario. The company is 100% Canadian owned as defined under the Telecommunications Act and the Canadian Telecommunications Common Carrier Ownership and Control Regulations.
3. Kincardine Cable understands and will conform to the best of its ability to the CLEC obligations as set out in Decision 97-8 and as modified from time to time. Some of these obligations may be fulfilled through a third party SILEC partner with which Kincardine plans to operate its local telephone service.

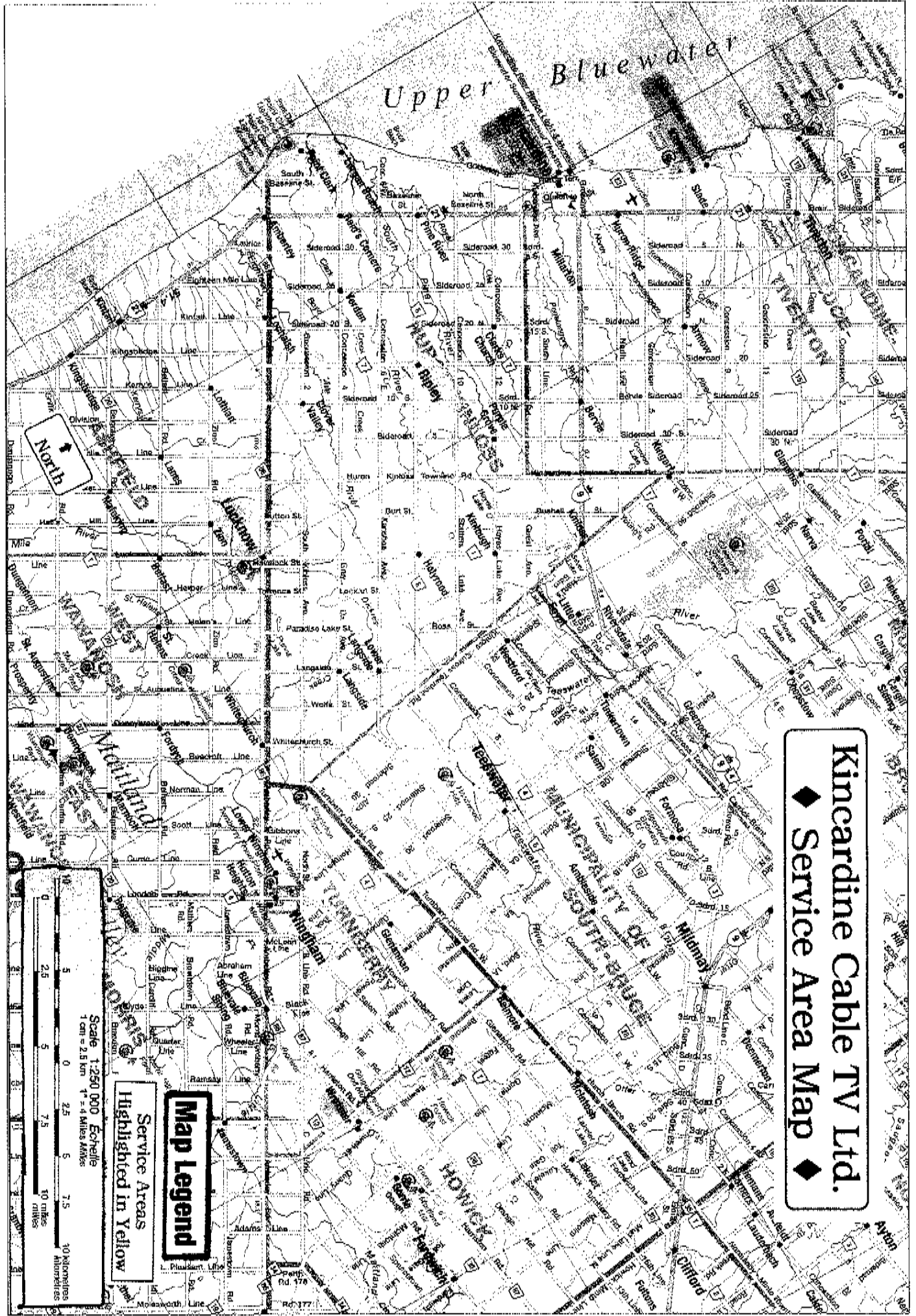
4. Kincardine Cable is providing a map of its serving area (attached) and will make this map available at its business office upon request. Kincardine's service area is within the territories of three SILECs, Bruce Municipal Telephone System, Huron Telecommunications Co-Operative Ltd. and Wightman Communications Ltd. as well as partially within Bell Canada territory. Kincardine wrote to all three SILECs in October 2007 informing them of our intention to enter the local exchange market and requesting that they develop plans to open their markets to competition. To date there has been little feedback.
5. The service areas noted on the attached map are as follows: Kincardine, Tiverton, Inverhuron, Lake Huron Highlands, Bruce Beach, Lurgan Beach, Point Clark, Amberley Beach, Lucknow, Ripley, Teeswater, Gorrie, Fordwich, Wroxeter, and Belgrave.
6. Kincardine Cable TV will provide a copy of this Registration Letter to other carriers which have filed a letter of registration with the Commission.
7. Kincardine Cable TV respectfully requests that the Commission recognize the company as a CLEC at this time in order to make the necessary arrangements to allow it to provide competitive local switched services and to provide a clear signal to the SILECs that we are a bone fide competitor.
