RE: Yak Communications (Canada) Corp. — Competitive Local Exchange Carrier Registration for the Additional Markets of Edmonton, Calgary and Vancouver

1. Pursuant to Telecom Decision CRTC 97-8 ("**Decision 97-8**"), Yak Communications (Canada) Corp. ("**Yak**") hereby submits this letter as notice of intent to enter the local exchange telephone market and offer switched local telephone services as a competitive local exchange carrier (CLEC) in the Edmonton, Calgary and Vancouver exchanges ("**Additional Markets**").
2. In a letter dated 18 September 2008 the Commission staff determined that Yak had completed the pre-entry CLEC requirements and authorized Yak to make further arrangements to provide local switched services in the Toronto LIR.
3. Yak hereby requests Commission recognition as a proposed CLEC in the Additional Markets.
4. Prior to commencing service in these Additional Markets, Yak will file detailed serving area maps and all required tariffs and agreements with the Commission for approval. Yak hereby attests that it understands and will conform to all CLEC obligations required by the Commission in Decision 97-8 and the Commission's subsequent rulings.
5. Copies of this letter are being provided to all ILECs, LECs and proposed CLECs identified on the Commission's website as operating or proposing to operate in these markets.
