CKOE-FM Moncton – Licence renewal

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the specialty commercial radio programming undertaking CKOE-FM Moncton, from 1 September 2005 to 31 August 2012.
2. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
3. The licence will be subject to the **conditions** set out in *New licence form for commercial radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1999-137, 24 August 1999, as well as to the following **conditions of licence**:
 - The station shall be operated within the Specialty format as defined in *A Review of Certain Matters Concerning Radio*, Public Notice CRTC 1995-60, 21 April 1995, as amended from time to time.
 - During each broadcast week, at least 92% of all musical selections broadcast shall be drawn from subcategory 35 (non-classic religious).
 - During each broadcast week, no more than 20% of all musical selections broadcast shall be hit material as defined in *Revised Policy on the Use of Hits by English-Language FM Radio Stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1997-42, 23 April 1997, as amended from time to time.

4. In accordance with *Implementation of an employment equity policy*, Public Notice CRTC 1992-59, 1 September 1992, the Commission encourages the licensee to consider employment equity issues in its hiring practices and in all other aspects of its management of human resources.
