### **CHOY-FM Moncton – Licence renewal**

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the French-language commercial radio programming undertaking CHOY-FM Moncton, from 1 September 2005 to 31 August 2012.
2. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
3. The Commission notes that in *New commercial French-language FM radio service in Moncton*, Decision CRTC 2000-361, 24 August 2000 (Decision 2000-361), the licensee was required by condition of licence to make annual contributions of \$22,000 over a seven-year period (a total of \$154,000) for an annual talent contest not including the associated promotional budget. This annual event is to be broadcast and used to promote Francophone talent in the Moncton area and in the neighbouring counties of Westmorland and Kent.
4. The licence will be subject to the **conditions** set out in *New licence form for commercial radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1999-137, 24 August 1999, as well as to the following **condition**:

In addition to the contributions required pursuant to condition of licence #5 set out in Public Notice CRTC 1999-137, the licensee shall contribute a minimum of \$22,000 per year for the promotion of Canadian talent as described at paragraph 27 of Decision 2000-361, until the licensee's total contributions, including those made during the previous licence term, equal \$154,000.

5. In accordance with *Implementation of an employment equity policy*, Public Notice CRTC 1992-59, 1 September 1992, the Commission encourages the licensee to consider employment equity issues in its hiring practices and in all other aspects of its management of human resources.
