



## Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2005-470

Ottawa, 20 September 2005

**Manitoulin Radio Communication Inc.**  
Little Current, Ontario

*Application 2005-0995-3*

### **CFRM-FM Little Current – Technical change**

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Manitoulin Radio Communication Inc. to change the authorized contours of the radio programming undertaking CFRM-FM Little Current, by increasing the effective radiated power from 5 watts to 45 watts and by decreasing the antenna height.
2. The licensee wishes to increase the signal of the station to better serve the community.
3. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
5. Given that the technical parameters approved in this decision are for a low-power unprotected FM service, the Commission also reminds the licensee that it will have to select another frequency if the Department so requires.
