Adult Classic Hit FM radio station in Kincardine, and its transmitters in Goderich and Port Elgin – Technical change

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Brian Cooper and Daniel McCarthy, on behalf of a corporation to be incorporated, to change the authorized contours of the radio programming undertaking authorized in *Adult Classic Hit FM radio station in Kincardine, with transmitters in Goderich and Port Elgin*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2005-68, 17 February 2005, by relocating the transmitter.
2. The Commission notes that there will be no significant change to the authorized contours of the undertaking.
3. The Commission reminds the applicant that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
