### **CBN-FM St. John's – New transmitter in Marystown**

1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CBN-FM St. John's, in order to operate an FM transmitter in Marystown to rebroadcast the programming of its national, English-language network service Radio Two.
2. The new transmitter will operate at 91.7 MHz (channel 219C) with an effective radiated power of 100,000 watts.
3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
5. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 29 March 2008. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
