CFLZ-FM Niagara Falls – Technical changes

1. The Commission **approves** the application by CJRN 710 Inc. to change the authorized contours of the English-language commercial radio programming undertaking CFLZ-FM Niagara Falls, by decreasing the average effective radiated power from 7,200 watts to 4,000 watts, by decreasing the antenna height and by relocating the transmitter.
2. The licensee indicated that the proposed changes would provide much better coverage within its licensed area and would therefore improve the service.
3. The Commission received interventions in support of this application.
4. The Commission notes that the authorized contours of the station will change significantly as a result of the technical changes approved in this decision. The coverage area in the United States will also be reduced.
5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
