CJLR-FM La Ronge – New transmitter at Yorkton

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Natotawin Broadcasting Inc. to amend the broadcasting licence for the Native radio programming undertaking CJLR-FM La Ronge, in order to operate a transmitter at Yorkton.
2. The new transmitter will operate at 92.9 MHz (channel 225A) with an effective radiated power of 1,260 watts.
3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
4. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
6. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 25 October 2006. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
