English-language FM radio station in Strathroy – Technical change

1. The Commission **approves** the application by My Broadcasting Corporation (MBC) to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking authorized in *English-language FM radio station in Strathroy*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2006-571, 3 October 2006 (Decision 2006-571), in order to change the frequency from 91.1 MHz (channel 216A) to 105.7 MHz (channel 289A).
2. In Decision 2006-571, the Commission noted an intervention by CJRT-FM Inc., the licensee of CJRT-FM Toronto, Ontario, in which CJRT-FM Inc. expressed concerns over MBC's proposed use of 91.1 MHz related to the potential for interference to CJRT-FM. The Commission also noted MBC's willingness to file an application to amend its licence to use 105.7 MHz, if necessary.
3. The Commission received an intervention in support of this application from CJRT-FM Inc.
4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
