CKII-FM Dolbeau – Licence renewal

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the French-, English- and Native-language Type B native FM radio programming undertaking CKII-FM Dolbeau, from 1 September 2007 to 31 August 2014.

Appendix to Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2007-250

Conditions of licence

1. During each broadcast week, at least 35% of all musical selections drawn from Category 2 shall be Canadian selections broadcast in their entirety.
2. During each broadcast week, not less than 45 hours of programming shall be broadcast in Native languages.
3. The licensee shall adhere to the guidelines on gender portrayal set out in the Canadian Association of Broadcasters' (CAB) *Sex-role portrayal code for television and radio programming*, as amended from time to time and approved by the Commission.
4. The licensee shall adhere to the provisions of the CAB's *Broadcast code for advertising to children*, as amended from time to time and approved by the Commission.
