### **CIMX-FM Windsor – Licence renewal**

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the English-language commercial FM radio programming undertaking CIMX-FM Windsor, from 1 September 2007 to 31 August 2014.
2. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
3. The licence will be subject to the **conditions** set out in *New licence form for commercial radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1999-137, 24 August 1999, with the exception of condition of licence number 5. The licence will also be subject to the **conditions** set out in the appendix to this decision.
4. Because this licensee is subject to the *Employment Equity Act* and files reports concerning employment equity with the Department of Human Resources and Skills Development, its employment equity practices are not examined by the Commission.

## Appendix to Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2007-251

1. The licence will be subject to the conditions set out in *New licence form for commercial radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1999-137, 24 August 1999, with the exception of condition of licence number 5.
2. The licensee shall, as an exception to the percentage of Canadian musical selections set out in sections 2.2(8) and 2.2(9) of the *Radio Regulations, 1986*, in any broadcast week:
  - devote, in that broadcast week, 20% or more of its musical selections from content category 2 to Canadian selections broadcast in their entirety; and
  - devote, between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., in the period from Monday to Friday of the same broadcast week, 20% or more of its musical selections from content category 2 to Canadian selections broadcast in their entirety.
3. a) The licensee shall make a basic annual contribution to Canadian Content Development (CCD). The amount of this contribution shall be determined in accordance with the *Commercial Radio Policy 2006*, Broadcasting Public Notice CRTC 2006-158, 15 December 2006 (Broadcasting Public Notice 2006-158), as amended from time to time.  
  
b) the licensee shall allocate 60% of its basic annual CCD contribution to FACTOR or MUSICACTION.  
  
c) the remaining amounts of this basic annual contribution shall be allocated to eligible parties and activities as defined in Broadcasting Public Notice 2006-158.

This condition of licence shall expire upon the coming into force of the amendments to the *Radio Regulations, 1986* relating to CCD.

4. During each broadcast week, the licensee shall devote a minimum of 5% of all programming to spoken word programming.
5. During each broadcast week, the licensee shall devote a minimum of 1 hour and 30 minutes to news programming.

For the purposes of these conditions, the terms “broadcast week,” “Canadian selection,” “content category” and “musical selection” shall have the same meaning as that set out in the *Radio Regulations, 1986*.
