CJTK-FM Sudbury and its transmitters CJTK-FM-1 North Bay and CJTK-FM-2 Little Current – Licence renewal

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the English-language, commercial Specialty FM radio programming undertaking CJTK-FM Sudbury and its transmitters CJTK-FM-1 North Bay and CJTK-FM-2 Little Current, from 1 September 2007 until 31 August 2014.
2. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
3. The licence will be subject to the **conditions** set out in *New licence form for commercial radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1999-137, 24 August 1999, with the exception of conditions of licence numbers 5 and 8. The licence will also be subject to the **conditions** set out in the appendix to this decision.
4. In accordance with *Implementation of an employment equity policy*, Public Notice CRTC 1992-59, 1 September 1992, the Commission encourages the licensee to consider employment equity issues in its hiring practices and in all other aspects of its management of human resources.

Appendix to Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2007-253

1. The licence will be subject to the conditions set out in *New licence form for commercial radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1999-137, 24 August 1999, with the exception of conditions of licence numbers 5 and 8.
2. The station shall be operated within the Specialty format as defined in *A review of certain matters concerning radio*, Public Notice CRTC 1995-60, 21 April 1995, and *Revised content categories and subcategories for radio*, Public Notice CRTC 2000-14, 28 January 2000, as amended from time to time.
3. a) The licensee shall make a basic annual contribution to Canadian Content Development (CCD). The amount of this contribution shall be determined in accordance with *Commercial Radio Policy 2006*, Broadcasting Public Notice CRTC 2006-158, 15 December 2006 (Broadcasting Public Notice 2006-158), as amended from time to time.

b) the licensee shall allocate 60% of its basic annual CCD contribution to the Foundation Assisting Canadian Talent on Recordings (FACTOR) or MUSICACTION.

c) the remaining amounts of this basic annual contribution shall be allocated to eligible parties and activities as defined in Broadcasting Public Notice 2006-158.

This condition of licence shall expire upon the coming into force of the amendments to the *Radio Regulations, 1986* relating to CCD.
4. The licensee shall, in each broadcast week, devote 20% or more of its musical selections from content category 3 to Canadian selections broadcast in their entirety and schedule them in a reasonable manner throughout each broadcast day.
5. The licensee shall broadcast no more than four minutes of commercial messages in each broadcast hour.
