CFML Burnaby – Licence renewal

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the English-language carrier current radio programming undertaking CFML Burnaby from 1 September 2007 to 31 August 2014, subject to the **conditions** specified in this decision and in the licence to be issued.
2. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
3. The renewal of this licence falls within the scope of the *Campus radio policy* (Public Notice 2000-12). In that notice, the Commission stated that it would require licensed carrier current stations to adhere to the same advertising restrictions that apply to campus stations.
4. Therefore, it is a **condition of licence** that the licensee broadcast no more than 504 minutes of advertising (content category 5) during each broadcast week, with a maximum of 4 minutes in any hour of the broadcast week.
5. As well, as a further **condition of licence**, the licensee shall devote, in each broadcast week, 12% or more of its musical selections from content category 3 (Special Interest Music) to Canadian selections broadcast in their entirety.
6. In addition, the Commission reminds the licensee that in accordance with the requirements of P.C. 1997-486, 8 April 1997, *Direction to the CRTC (Ineligibility of non-Canadians)*, as amended by P.C. 1998-1268, 15 July 1998, the Chair and not less than 80% of the members of the board of directors must be Canadians ordinarily resident in Canada.
