### CRTC Interconnection Steering Committee – Consensus items

#### Consensus report submitted to the CISC Steering Committee

1. The Canadian Steering Committee on Numbering (CSCN) of the CRTC Interconnection Steering Committee (CISC) submitted a consensus report to the CISC Steering Committee (SC).
2. On 22 December 2006, the SC approved the following report:
  - CSCN – *CSCN TIF 73 Modifications to the Canadian MIN Block Identifier (MBI) Assignment Guideline*, 1 December 2006 (CNRE065A). Modifications to section 5.6 of the Canadian MBI Assignment Guidelines would allow assignment of partial MBIs only in circumstances where the current assignment rule, that MBIs be assigned at the 10,000 number block level as opposed to the 1,000 block level, creates a risk of delaying wireless number portability.
3. The consensus report was referred to the Commission for consideration. The report is available through the Commission's website.
4. The Commission has reviewed and **approves** the above-noted consensus report.
