1. **Toronto, Ontario** **Application No. 2007-1610-3**

Application by **CJRT-FM Inc.**, a not-for-profit corporation, relating to the licence of the English-language radio programming undertaking CJRT-FM Toronto, Ontario.

The licensee proposes to replace its predominantly Korean-language Subsidiary Communications Multiplex Operations (SCMO) radio service, approved in Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2005-474, by a predominantly Hindi and Tamil-language SCMO radio service which will offer programming consisting of both music and spoken word, including religious programming.

The licensee indicates that its SCMO Korean-language radio service ceased its operations in August 2007 and proposes the above-noted service as a replacement.

Programming broadcast using an SCMO channel is not accessible with standard radio equipment and requires the use of a special receiver.

Application by the **Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC)** relating to the licence of the AM radio programming undertaking CBR Calgary, Alberta.

The CBC proposes to change the authorized contours of the nested transmitter CBR-1-FM Calgary, Alberta by increasing the effective radiated power from 1,100 watts to an average effective radiated power of 2,800 watts and by decreasing the effective antenna height (maximum effective radiated power of 10,000 watts/effective antenna height 275 metres).

The CBC advises that shortly after CBR-1-FM became operational, it received a number of complaints from residents located in downtown Calgary mostly about reception in apartment buildings. According to the CBC, the changes requested would improve the signal reception in the city core.

Application by the **Canadian Broadcasting Corporation** to amend the licence of the radio programming undertaking CBUF-FM Vancouver, British Columbia.

The licensee proposes to add an FM transmitter at Whistler, British Columbia to broadcast its programming service La Première Chaîne originating from CBUF-FM Vancouver in order to serve the population of Whistler.

The transmitter would operate on frequency 103.1 MHz (channel 276A) with an average effective radiated power of 240 watts (maximum effective radiated power 500 watts/effective antenna height of -238.3 metres).
