CJLU-FM Halifax – New FM transmitter at Wolfville

1. The Commission **approves** the application by International Harvesters for Christ Evangelistic Association Inc. (International Harvesters) to amend the broadcasting licence of the English-language specialty FM radio programming undertaking CJLU-FM Halifax in order to add an FM transmitter at Wolfville, Nova Scotia.
2. The new transmitter will operate at 88.3 MHz (channel 202A) with an average effective radiated power of 175 watts.
3. International Harvesters indicated that the new FM transmitter is intended to provide a religious FM radio service to the people of the Annapolis Valley.
4. The Commission received interventions in support of this application.
5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
6. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 21 May 2010. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
