CFAN-FM Miramichi – Licence renewal

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licence for the English-language commercial FM radio programming undertaking CFAN-FM Miramichi from 1 January 2009¹ to 31 August 2015.
2. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
3. The licence will be subject to the **conditions** set out in Public Notice 1999-137, with the exception of conditions 1 and 5, as well as condition 9 relating to the solicitation of local advertising, which does not apply to stations operating in a single-station market. The licence will also be subject to the **conditions** set out in the appendix to this decision.
4. The Commission reminds the licensee that it is required to adhere to the requirements relating to contributions to Canadian content development set out in section 15 of the *Radio Regulations, 1986*, as amended by *Regulations Amending the Radio Regulations, 1986*, SOR/2008-177, 28 May 2008, announced in Broadcasting Public Notice 2008-67.

Appendix to Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2008-272

Conditions of licence

1. The licence shall be subject to the conditions set out in *New licence form for commercial radio stations*, Public Notice CRTC 1999-137, 24 August 1999, with the exception of conditions 1, 5 and 9.
2. If the licensee broadcasts 42 or more hours of programming in any broadcast week, the licensee shall adhere to the Canadian Association of Broadcasters' *Equitable Portrayal Code*, as amended from time to time and approved by the Commission. However, the application of the foregoing condition of licence will be suspended if the licensee is a member in good standing of the Canadian Broadcast Standards Council.

Encouragement

Employment equity
