### **CKEM-TV Edmonton – Licence amendment – Correction**

1. In *CKEM-TV Edmonton – Licence amendment*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2010-234, 26 April 2010 (Broadcasting Decision 2010-234), the Commission approved an application by Rogers Broadcasting Limited to amend the broadcasting licence for the television programming undertaking CKEM-TV Edmonton. Specifically, the Commission approved the addition of a transitional digital television (DTV) transmitter in Edmonton to broadcast the programming of CKEM-TV. In paragraphs 1 and 2 of that decision, the DTV transmitter should have been described as “post-transitional.”
2. Accordingly, the first two paragraphs of Broadcasting Decision 2010-234 shall now read as follows (changes relating to the type of transmitter are indicated in bold):
  1. The Commission **approves** the application by Rogers Broadcasting Limited (Rogers) to amend the broadcasting licence for the television programming undertaking CKEM-TV Edmonton in order to add a **post-transitional** digital television (DTV) transmitter in Edmonton to broadcast the programming of CKEM-TV. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
  2. The new **post-transitional** DTV transmitter will operate on channel 17 with an average effective radiated power (ERP) of 85,000 watts (a maximum ERP of 107,000 watts with an effective height of antenna above average terrain of 294 metres).
