CBFX-FM Montréal – Technical changes

1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) to modify the technical parameters for the French-language radio programming undertaking CBFX-FM Montréal by changing the polarization of the antenna from horizontal to circular and by increasing the effective height of antenna above average terrain from 242.5 to 298.9 meters. All other technical parameters remain unchanged. The Commission did not receive any interventions regarding this application.
2. The CBC indicated that this change will improve the quality of CBFX-FM's signal in the greater Montréal area.
3. The Commission reminds the licensee that pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
