HPItv – Revocation of licence

1. Woodbine Entertainment Group has requested the revocation of its broadcasting licence for the national English-language specialty Category B service HPItv, originally granted in Broadcasting Decision 2000-713, in order to continue its operation as an exempt undertaking, pursuant to Broadcasting Order 2015-88.
2. Given the licensee's request and pursuant to section 9(1)(e) of the *Broadcasting Act*, the Commission **revokes** the broadcasting licence issued to Woodbine Entertainment Group for the above-mentioned undertaking.
3. The operator of this undertaking must, at all times, comply with the criteria set out in the appendix to Broadcasting Order 2015-88.
