1. The Commission **approves on a final basis** the following tariff applications:

2. The Commission received no interventions with respect to the applications.

In accordance with the 2019 Policy Direction,<sup>3</sup> the Commission considers that this order, which is based on a complete record, can promote competition, affordability, consumer interests, and innovation. Specifically, final approval of this application will promote (i) consumer interests by ensuring consistency of terms across all of these Bell company tariffs and (ii) innovation by ensuring that customers will continue to have access to high-quality telecommunications services.
5. Revised tariff pages are to be issued within 10 calendar days of the date of this order. Revised tariff pages can be submitted to the Commission without a description page or a request for approval; a tariff application is not required.
