Bell Canada – Final approval of a tariff application

1. The Commission **approves on a final basis** the following tariff application:

Applicant	Tariff Notice and description	Date of application	Effective date
Bell Canada	TN 7608 General Tariff - Introduction of a new migration clause for Megalink Service	10 February 2020	25 February 2020

2. The Commission received no interventions with respect to the application.
3. In accordance with subparagraph 1(b)(i) of the 2006 Policy Direction,¹ the Commission considers that final approval of this application will advance the policy objective set out in paragraph 7(f) of the *Telecommunications Act*.²
4. In accordance with the 2019 Policy Direction,³ the Commission considers that this order, which is based on a complete record, can promote competition, affordability, consumer interests, and innovation. Specifically, the final approval of this application will promote consumer interests and innovation, since it (i) provides additional flexibility by allowing customers to migrate a Megalink Service that is under the terms of a minimum contract period (MCP) to access services lines that are also subject to the terms of an MCP, and (ii) ensures that such customers will continue to have access to high-quality telecommunications services as a result of the new migration clause.
