Various Indigenous (Type B Native) radio programming undertakings – Administrative renewals

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licences for the Indigenous (Type B Native) radio programming undertakings set out in the appendix to this decision from 1 September 2022 to 31 August 2023, subject to the terms and **conditions** in effect under the current licences.
2. This decision does not dispose of any issues that may arise with respect to the renewal of these licences, including any non-compliance issues. The Commission reminds licensees that they must, at all times, operate their undertakings in compliance with their current conditions of licence, the *Radio Regulations, 1986* (which includes the requirement to submit annual returns for each broadcast year by a prescribed deadline), and any other obligations.
