Decision of the Broadcasting Arbitrator

1. On 25 August 2022, the Broadcasting Arbitrator released a decision, with reasons, and an order with respect to the 2022 Allocation of Paid Time. This decision, made pursuant to subsections 337(3) and 343(2) of the *Canada Elections Act* (the Act), replaces the 2021 Allocation of Paid Time.
2. The Commission is required, pursuant to subsection 342(1) of the Act, to notify broadcasters and network operators of such allocations.
