## Terrestrial broadcasting distribution undertaking serving Red Deer, Alberta – Revocation of licence

- 1. The Commission received an application by Rogers Communications Canada Inc., on behalf of Shaw Cablesystems Limited, in which the licensee has confirmed its eligibility for exemption in accordance with the terms and conditions of the exemption order for terrestrial broadcasting distribution undertakings serving fewer than 20,000 subscribers (Broadcasting Order 2017-320), set out in the appendix to Broadcasting Regulatory Policy 2017-319.
- 2. Given the licensee's request and pursuant to paragraph 9(1)(f) of the *Broadcasting Act*, the Commission **revokes** the broadcasting licence issued to Rogers Communications Canada Inc., on behalf of Shaw Cablesystems Limited, for the undertaking serving Red Deer, Alberta, last renewed in Broadcasting Decision 2023-245.
- 3. The operator of this undertaking must, at all times, comply with the criteria contained in Broadcasting Order 2017-320.
