RE: Rogers Home Phone Inc. Tariff Notice 26

1. Aliant Telecom Inc. ("Aliant" or the "Company") is in receipt of Rogers Home Phone Inc's ("RHPI") Tariff Notice 26 ("TN 26"), filed with the Commission on 2006 01 12. In TN 26, Rogers Communications Inc. (Rogers) proposes to revise RHPI's tariff to incorporate the tariff for Third Party Internet Access ("TPIA").
2. In the January 12 application, Rogers identifies that it is restructuring its organization by transferring all of its local exchange services and TPIA services from Rogers Cable Communications Inc. ("RCCI") to Rogers Home Phone Inc. (formerly Call-Net Communications Inc).
3. While Aliant is not opposing RHPI's application at this time, but because Rogers' request is unclear, the Company asks the Commission to direct Rogers to clearly state which of its companies provides retail internet service today and if this will change with the migration of the TPIA tariff to RHPI.
4. Aliant submits that, depending on which Rogers' company provides the retail internet service, the application to migrate the TPIA tariff to RHPI may or may not be appropriate.
