Re: Rogers Home Phone Inc. Tariff Notice 26

1. This is in reply to a letter from Rogers Communications Inc. ("Rogers") of 2006 02 08 in respect to Tariff Notice 26 of Rogers Home Phone Inc. ("RHPI"), in which Rogers states that its retail internet service is provided by Rogers Telecom Inc. and that this service arrangement is irrelevant to the disposition of TN 26.
2. In its earlier letter of 2006 01 12, Rogers proposes to move its Third Party Internet Access ("TPIA") services to RHPI, while Rogers will continue to provide its retail internet services via Rogers Telecom Inc.
3. Aliant identifies that when TPIA was mandated by the Commission in Telecom Decision CRTC 99-8, Regulation under the Telecommunications Act of Cable Carriers' Access Services, the intent of the decision was for the major cable carriers to provide the equivalent IP data transmission capabilities for TPIA that they use to provide their own retail services.
4. Contrary to the assertion of Rogers, for the reason stated in paragraph three above, it is indeed relevant that the retail and wholesale internet services be provided by the same company.
