Re: **Société TELUS Communications – Application for forbearance from the regulation of residential local exchange services in ten exchanges in Quebec. File No: 8640-T69-200904690**

1. Rogers Communications Inc. (Rogers) is in receipt of an application by TELUS Communications Company dated March 9, 2009 requesting forbearance from the regulation of residential local exchange services in the Amqui, Batiscan, Causapscal, Lac-au-Saumon, Sainte-Anne-de-la-Pérade, Saint-Stanislas, Saint-Tite, Saint-Ulric, Sayabec et Val-Brillant exchanges in Quebec.
2. Pursuant to the Commission staff letter dated 7 June 2007, Rogers confirms that its wireless service provides coverage in areas containing 75% of the number of residential local exchange service lines in the following four exchanges: Batiscan, Sainte-Anne-de-la-Pérade, Saint-Stanislas, and Saint-Tite.
3. Rogers wireless service is does not provide coverage in areas containing 75% of the number of residential local exchange service lines in the following six exchanges: Amqui, Causapscal, Lac-au-Saumon, Saint-Ulric, Sayabec, and Val-Brillant.
